6 - 8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ FVRCP-P #1 (Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Pneumonitis, and Panleukopenia)</li><li>▪ Intestinal Parasite Exam (Intestinal worms)</li><li>▪ Feline Leukemia (FeLV) Test</li><li>▪ Flea and/or tick prevention</li></ul>
10 – 12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ FVRCP-P #2 and FeLV #1</li><li>▪ Flea and/or tick prevention</li></ul>
14 – 16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ FVRCP-P, Rabies, and FeLV #2</li><li>▪ Flea and/or tick prevention</li></ul>
Monthly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Flea and/or tick prevention</li></ul>
6 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Spay or Neuter – Please call to schedule an appointment.</li><li>▪ Feline Aids (FIV) Test</li></ul>
Annually	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ FVRCP-P, Rabies, and FeLV</li><li>▪ Intestinal Parasite Exam (Intestinal worms)</li><li>▪ Comprehensive physical exam</li></ul>
